KEEP IT ALL STRAIGHT WITH THIS QUICK REFERENCE:

Account The name of the account the plot samples should be associated with and billed to. To ensure this is populated correctly, your login should be established and associated with all accounts within your jurisdiction prior to uploading a plot sample spreadsheet.

Additional Emails Include emails of any additional team members who need to recieve the results of the plot samples analyzed.

CSV A comma-delimited spreadsheet format. Users may choose to dowload a .csv file from FeedScan Web instead of label stickers. This file type allows users to easily submit and transfer data.

Delimiter A character or symbol that separates data on the same row of a label sticker. The default in FeedScan Web is a dash, but if your team prefers underscores, periods, or some other character between data, it can be updated accordingly.

Feed Product Crop type of the plot you're prepping to harvest and sample.

Packages The type of analysis that should be run on the plot samples. This is broken down between the various analysis formats - Near Infrared (NIR), Wet Chemistry, Wet Chemistry-Additional (these must be added to a NIR or Wet Chemistry package already selected), Anti-nutritional Analysis, and Water Analysis. A package must be selected in order to proceed with sample label creation. For a detailed list of what each package includes, contact our customer service team.

Sample Date This date is automatically recognized (if it exists) on the uploaded spreadsheet, and is autofilled on the top of the sample labels. If no date(s) are provided within the spreadsheet, it will automatically default to include the date the labels are generated.
